General Information

- Two year undergraduate course commitment comprised of BS/MA track courses I I I AB, I96ABC
 - One year graduate course commitment for MA
 - I96ABC culminates in an Thesis and poster presentation
 - Minimum overall GPA of 3.3 to apply (if first year transfer student a minimum transfer GPA of 3.5)
 - Applications are available at the beginning of each fall quarter
 - **Deadline to submit application: October 30th**
 - Application are evaluated by December 1 and students will be notified via email thereafter
 - **Spring quarter of Senior year apply for MA program**

- List all courses in progress, and provide interim grades when possible
 - List course equivalents completed at another college or university
 - The letter of recommendation does not have to be confidential
 - The letter of recommendation can come from anyone who can speak of your academic ability (professor, lab manager, TA, supervisor, etc)
 - Sign up for Winter quarter courses as if you are not doing the BS/MA integrated program—if admitted to the BS/MA track you will receive clearance to enroll in PSYC I I I A at the beginning of winter quarter
